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Your Teaching and Pedagogical Considerations response:

It supports learning outcomes

This tool will give my students (who are faculty) the experience to use it with their own students. It is a private group of people and is meant to be a safe space to discuss values, pedagogy for remote learning and teaching practice in general.

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Your "Interaction" response:

The tool offers chat capability through text, voice or video. Participants can also create "channels" to discuss specific topics of interest as they progress through the learning experience.

So far there has been good interaction between participants. It is a busy week so i'm expecting most will be working on their learning over the weekend and will use the tool once they have been able to engage with the content.

I plan to post some more discussion topics related to the topics within the module to spark engagement.

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Your "Organisational Issues" response:

Our institution has a Centre for Teaching and Learning who support the development of teaching practice. It is very valuable and we are constantly changing our offerings to meet the diverse needs of faculty within the college.

In some cases faculty can be granted SWF time for professional development. but it's mostly voluntary and completed during personal time.
