The CARD lesson plan is like driving a car. Here are the component skills required to master delivering a CARD lesson plan.

Understand the purpose of a lesson plan (know how to drive a car to a destination)


Manage time and lesson delivery (know how to drive a car in different weather conditions)

Use Zoom tools to deliver the lesson (know how to turn on the car)



Understand the main components of the CARD lesson plan (Context, Activities, Reflection, Documentation) (know what a map or GPS is and how to use it)

Managing one's wellness, appearance, and physical needs to focus on the lesson (keeping the car and driver in healthy conditions, fueled up!)



Identify the context of the lesson to describe to students (know how to get to the destination from the driver's current location)

Identify the lesson activity, and prepare activity materials (know how to use the tools of the car to set direction, speed, acceleration, etc.)

Identify the reflection questions to ask students (know how manage speed, traffic flow to get to destination in time)

Identify the type of documentation, and prepare resource materials (remember the journey for the next trip)

Managing or stopping situations if necessary (knowing defensive driving skills, and checking mirrors for dangerous driving)

Guiding reflection, but avoid leading it (avoid getting upset and being an aggressive driver)

Reviewing documentation to determine learning (thinking about a shorter or better journey next time)
