## WIIFM Scrum Fundamentals

When teaching the Scrum Fundamentals (e.g., <a href="https://www.scrumalliance.org/learn-about-scrum/scrum-elearning-series">https://www.scrumalliance.org/learn-about-scrum/scrum-elearning-series</a>) in a Systems Analysis and Design course, students need to know the **benefits** of having a mastery of this topic:
