

## My Teaching Metaphor



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I have been a Professor in the Project Management program. The course is broken down into learning, practical, and exams.

The students participate in weekly Virtual Classes. They are allowed to take these learnings and apply them in group settings. The use of group work is beneficial to the students as it allows them to work in small groups (5 members), and manage the workload and conflict required in groups. Groups are randomly selected by the Professor, a student will get an opportunity to work with others in the class.

My class is a mix of Canadian-based students and international students. Students are located across Canada from big cities to remote mining locations, they have also been on off-shore drilling platforms off the coast of Nigeria.
