Comparisons between updated courses designed using more current practices with older courses that follow outdated practices.

That feedback is not always clear/useful and is not provided in a timely manner.

That there are too many tasks and assignments in the course.

Useful resources and training sessions and an online community in the LMS (that is not always used to its full potential).

Guidelines that are too vague and don't clearly outline outcomes.

Sometimes there is a lack of motivation and engagement in the course.

Want courses to have a manageable amount of summative tasks with corresponding (and detailed) rubrics.

Want to see less readings and discussion forum activities that don't properly call for collaboration - they want more practical tasks and resources.

Pain Points?

Proportion of readings and tasks are not conducive to learning

Inconsistencies from one course to another (within a series of courses)

Gain Points?

Student surveys that are actually read and taken into account

Better course structure, design and more clear and concise
