Enter your "Students" response:

My idea was to have students create a quizlet on the topic for grades outside of class rather than taking up in-class time to review. Students all have access to quizlet although it is a limited version. They can access from anywhere, they can also use an app. Students need to be able to type.

Enter your "Ease of Use" response

Quizlet is relatively easy to use after getting into the log-in. In fact, we used it in this lesson as a way to show the flashcard / matching feature. It is easy to maintain and quick to edit or search up. To encourage lasting content, students could keep a file of the definitions or terms they put in quizlet as well.

Enter your "Cost" response

The cost is free for a basic version. Students should be able to log-in and create a quizlet within half an hour if they already have their information collected. Some areas within the college have subscriptions to the premium version of Quizlet.

Your Teaching and Pedagogical Considerations response:

Having students create a quizlet not only reinforces their learning in the content, but allows them to review the material and get grades for the work they do outside of class. The idea is, that if they like the tool, they will continue to use it without extrinsic grade motivation.

Your "Interaction" response:

This tool allows students to share their Quizlets with each other and the professor fairly seamlessly. It develops tech literacy and study skills simultaneously.

Your "Organisational Issues" response:

I am unaware if Quizlet is a promoted tool by my institution as a whole. I have done program specific professional development with the tool, especially in regards to supporting high needs learners. One issue that can arise is that students may wish to use pre-populated quizlets to help them study and unfortunately, it's hard to determine what might be credible (like Kahoot).

Your "Networking" response:

This technology allows others to share their creations if they desire, however I am unaware of networking features within the app.

Your Security and Privacy response:

If there are privacy and security issues with Quizlet, I could reach out to my IT department and inquire. Another resource would be confirming with the School of Contemporary Teaching and Learning to determine what list of approved tools exists especially when asking students to create login accounts.
