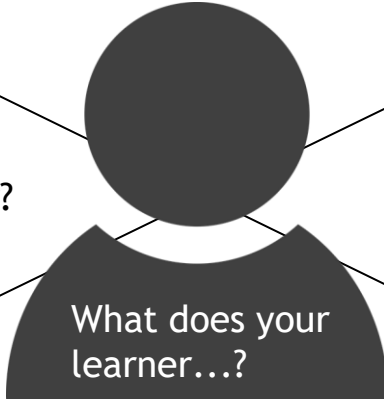


Think and Feel?

Difficult to remain fully attentive and focused due to long lectures and online format
