Additionally, another perspective that was noticeably absent was that of someone working at the intersection of AI and writing assessment.

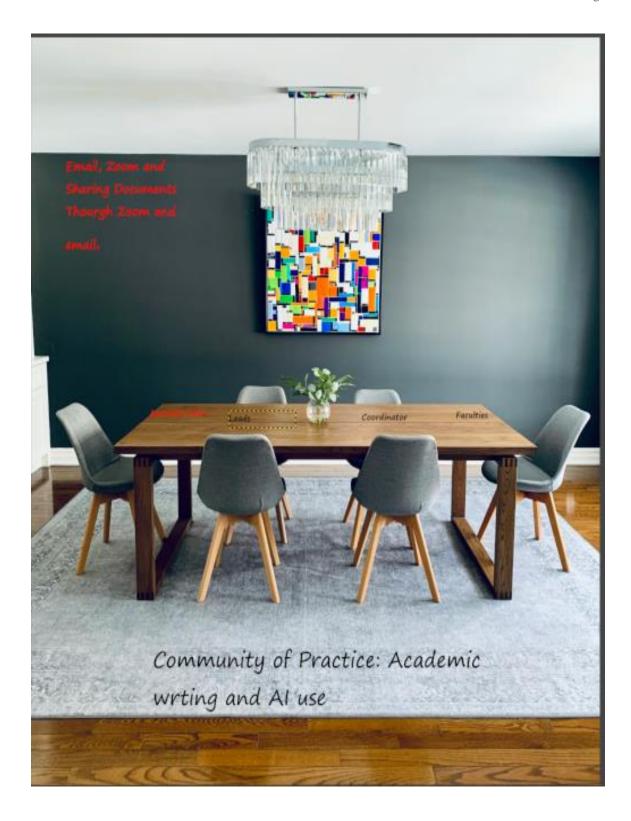
